Daniel Stout introduced guests and visiting Rotarians while conducting the Carithers Scholarship raffle.



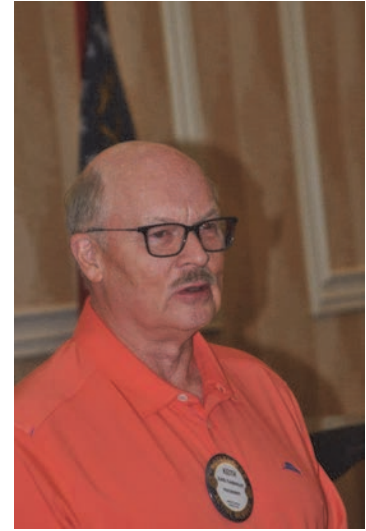
Jim Mosman won a floral arrangement in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.
